

Late Summer Scratch Card 2026
Free Prize Draw T&Cs

1. The Promoter

The promoter of this Prize Draw is Macmillan Cancer Support registered charity in England and Wales (261017), Scotland (SC039907) and the Isle of Man (604); a company limited by guarantee registered in England and Wales (02400969), Isle of Man company number 4694F. Registered office: 3rd Floor, Bronze Building, The Forge, 105 Sumner Street, London, SE1 9HZ ("**Macmillan, we, us, our**").

2. Overview

- 2.1 A free scratch card has been included in a limited number of our Macmillan Late Summer Raffle 2026 Packs ("**Scratch Card**"). If you scratch and reveal three matching symbols on your Scratch Card and comply with these terms and conditions ("**Terms and Conditions**"), you will be entered into a free prize draw (the "**Prize Draw**") for a chance to win the prize (outlined below). Entry to the Scratch Card Prize Draw is not dependent on entry to the Macmillan Late Summer Raffle 2026.
- 2.1 By entering the Prize Draw, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Promotional materials relating to the Prize Draw, including all information on how to enter the Prize Draw, also form part of these Terms and Conditions. In the event of any conflict between any terms referred to in such promotional materials and these Terms and Conditions, these Terms and Conditions take precedence.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 The Prize Draw is only open to individuals who:
- (a) are aged 18 years or over;
 - (b) are residents of Great Britain (which comprises England, Scotland and Wales, and excludes Northern Ireland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man);
 - (c) are not employees of the Charity, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with the administration of the Prize Draw; and
 - (d) have found three matching symbols on their Scratch Card.
- 3.2 In entering the Prize Draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize if you win. Macmillan may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the Prize Draw.
- 3.3 Macmillan will not accept Prize Draw entries that are:
- (a) automatically generated by computer;
 - (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
 - (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;

- (d) photocopies and not originals; or
- (e) incomplete.

- 3.4 There is a limit of one entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted, and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 3.5 Macmillan reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the Prize Draw.

4. How to enter

- 4.1 The Prize Draw will run concurrently alongside the Late Summer Raffle, from 00:01 GMT on 3 August 2026 (the "**Opening Date**") to 23:59 GMT on 2 October 2026 (the "**Closing Date**") inclusive.
- 4.2 All Prize Draw entries must be **received** by Macmillan by no later than 23:59 GMT on the Closing Date. All Prize Draw entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 4.3 To enter the Prize Draw, you can **either**:

- 1. **Free Entry Option:**

- (i) attach an address label to the designated address label box on the Scratch Card; and
 - (ii) return it to the Return Address prior to the Closing Date;

OR

- 2. **Raffle Ticket Option:**

- (i) purchase raffle tickets for the Macmillan Late Summer Raffle 2026; (ii) attach your address label to the Scratch Card and enclose it with your raffle ticket purchase; and (iii) return payment and counterfoils to Macmillan Late Summer Raffle 2026, Bumpers Way, Bumpers Farm, CHIPPENHAM, SN14 6NG ("**Return Address**") prior to the Closing Date

No other method of entry will be accepted. Reminder that entries received after the Closing Date will not be accepted.

- 4.4 Macmillan will **not** accept:

- (a) responsibility for Prize Draw entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
 - (b) proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the Prize Draw.

5. The prize

- 5.1 The prize is five hundred pounds and zero pence (£500.00).
- 5.2 Macmillan reserves the right to substitute the prize with a prize of equal or value.
- 5.3 The prize is not negotiable or transferable.
- 5.4 The prize winner will be selected by a random number generator on 16 October 2026 (the "**Draw Date**").

6. Winners

- 6.1 The decision of Macmillan is final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 6.2 Macmillan will notify the winner personally within 28 working days of the Draw Date by post using the name and address provided with the Prize Draw entry.
- 6.3 Macmillan must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation Macmillan will send the surname and county of major prize winners and, if applicable copies of their winning entries, to anyone who emails fundraising@macmillan.org.uk within one month after the Closing Date of the Prize Draw.
- 6.4 If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact Macmillan by email to fundraising@macmillan.org.uk. In such circumstances, Macmillan must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

7. Claiming the prize

- 7.1 You will not need to do anything to claim your prize. When Macmillan notifies you in line with clause 6.2, it will also enclose a cheque issued to the winner in the name provided with the winning Prize Draw entry. Details will be made available on the Macmillan website.
- 7.2 Macmillan will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available within 30 working days of the Draw Date, Macmillan reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 7.3 Macmillan also reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date where the original winner is found not to meet the Eligibility or entry requirements.
- 7.4 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.

- 7.5 Macmillan does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.
- 7.6 Any cheques that remain uncashed for 6 months after the Draw Date will be cancelled and any unclaimed prizes will be donated back to Macmillan to fund Macmillan's vital work.

8. Limitation of liability

Insofar as is permitted by law, Macmillan, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of Macmillan, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

9. Data protection and publicity

10. General

- 10.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, Macmillan may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the Prize Draw.
- 10.2 Macmillan reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the Prize Draw where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 10.3 These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
